Warblers to Waterfowl Weekend for Birders



Explore two of the most beautiful areas in Manitoba with renowned interpreter Cal Cuthbert. Saturday, Cal will take you to Riding Mountain National Park in search of colourful wood Warblers and other exciting boreal forest birds. Sunday, you'll tour Minnedosa's pothole country looking for Red-necked Grebes and other wetland birds.
